Content

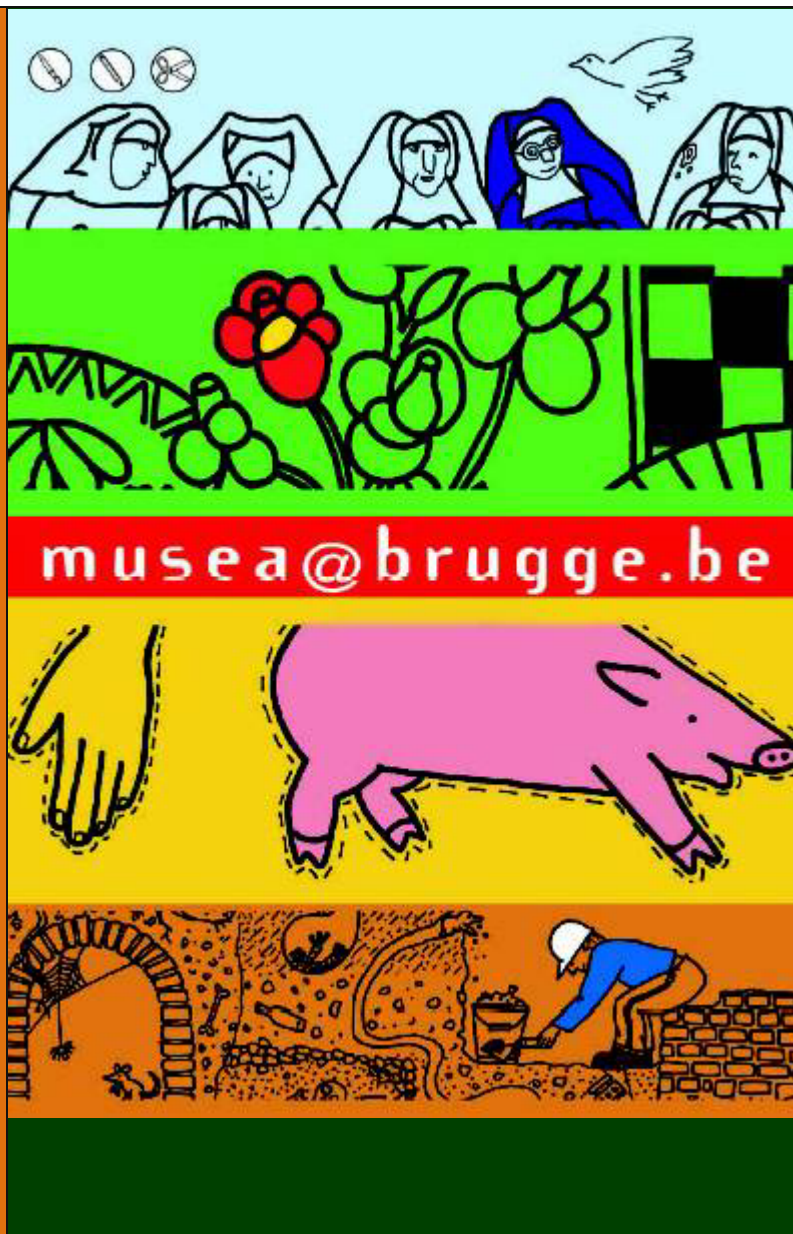
